Once again, and for the 25th year, the European Dermatology Forum will conduct its annual scientific meeting, open to members, guests and sponsoring partners.

This EDF Annual Meeting takes place each January in Switzerland and is designed to address several of the significant issues impacting dermato-venereology and ranging from clinical to political matters.

In January 2022, we will meet in Montreux, a traditional spa town nestled among steep hills on the shores of Lake Geneva. The town is known for its mild microclimate and the Montreux Jazz Festival in July. Magnificent Belle Époque buildings line the waterfront, which is lined with flowers, sculptures and Mediterranean trees. The medieval Chillon Castle is located on an island off shore. The moated castle includes ramparts, reception halls and a chapel with 14th-century murals.

The 2022 EDF Annual Meeting will be held at the Grand Hotel Suisse Majestic, a 4-star superior hotel in the style of the Belle Époque situated at the heart of Montreux, directly on the banks of Lake Geneva. For the main meeting, as usual, we will discuss and debate a wide range of current dermatology and dermato-venereology topics. Kindly refer to the full list of activities in the preliminary program.







FLOORPLAN

1^{er} étage




2^e étage

The official language of the congress will be English.


Insurance, liability


