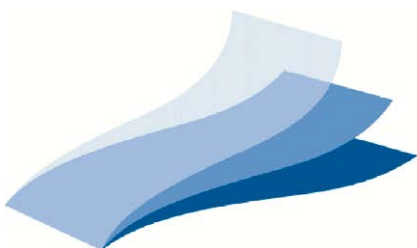

Once again, and for the 23rd consecutive year, the European Dermatology Forum will hold its annual scientific meeting, open to members, guests and sponsoring partners.

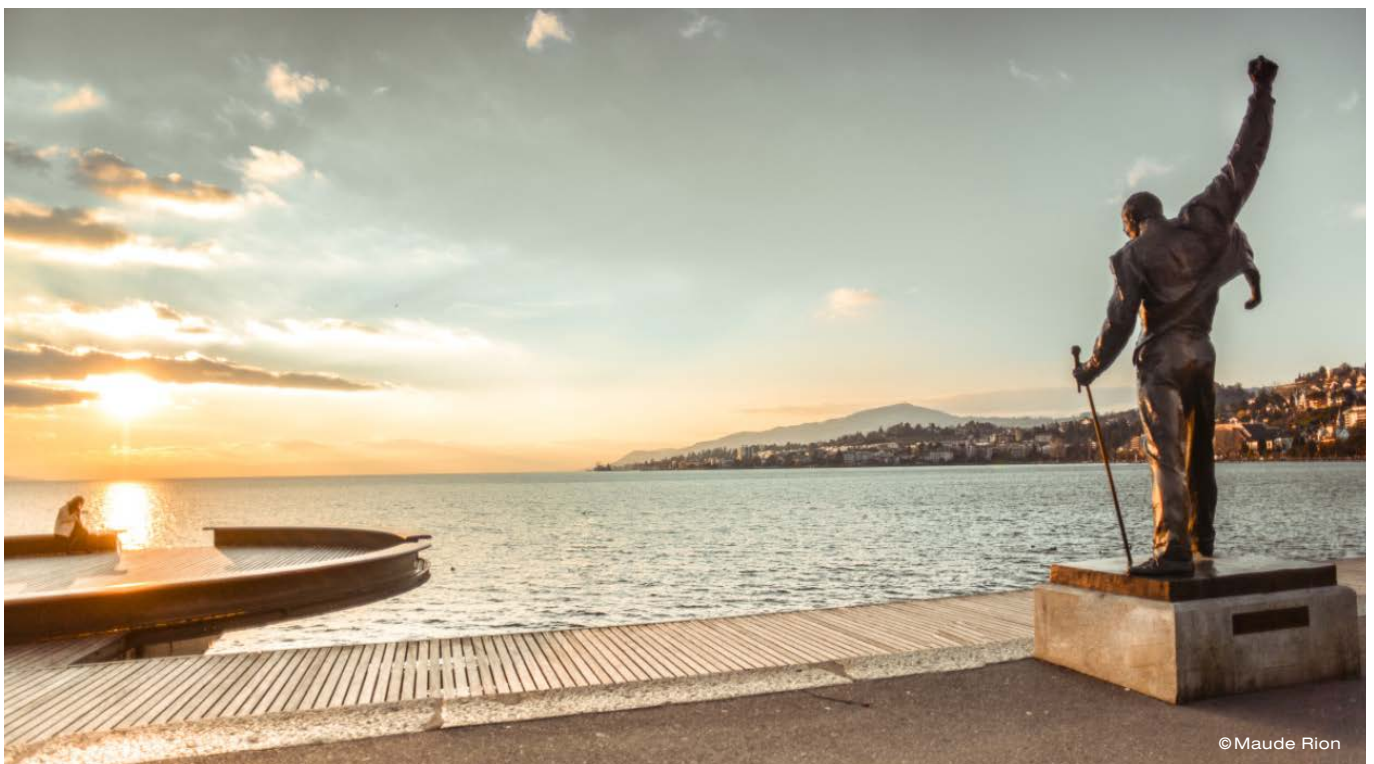

1^{er} étage

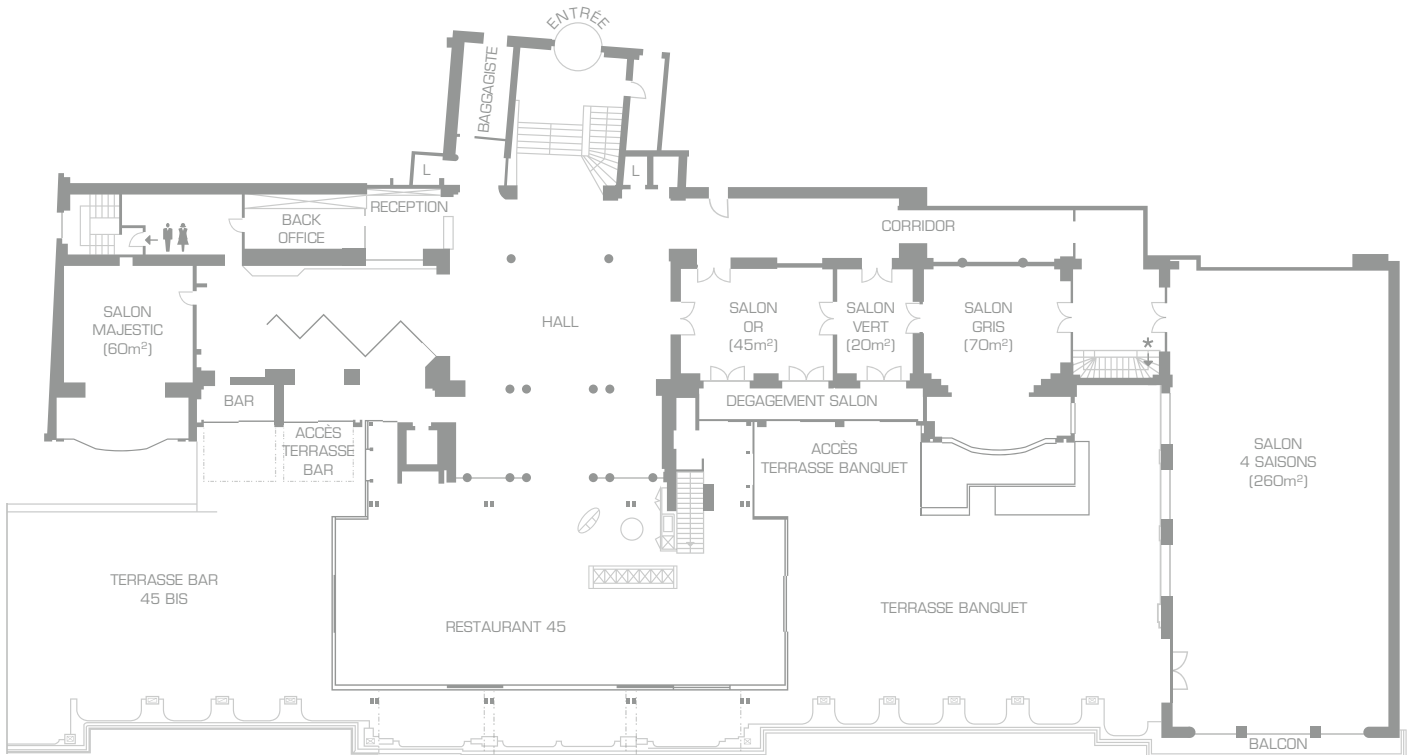

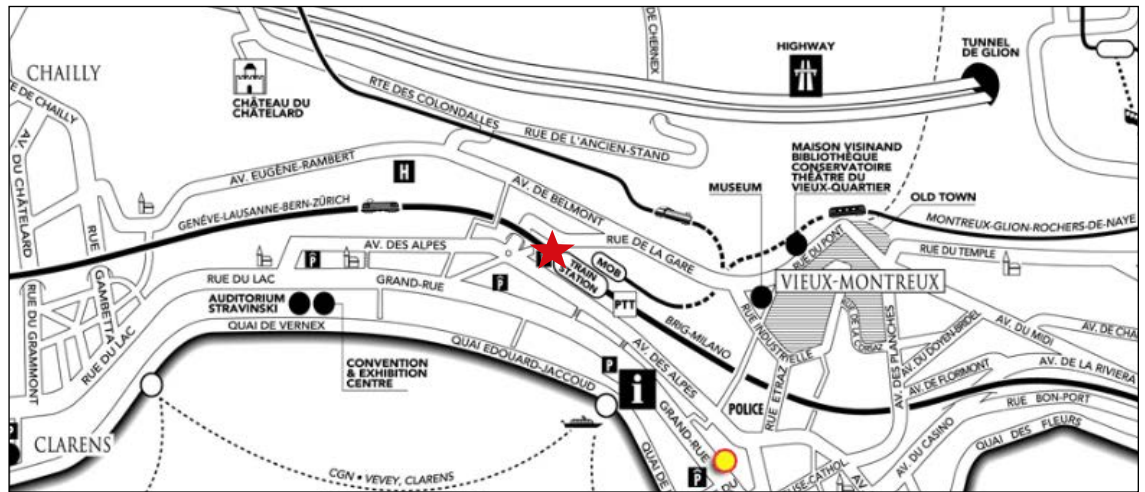
