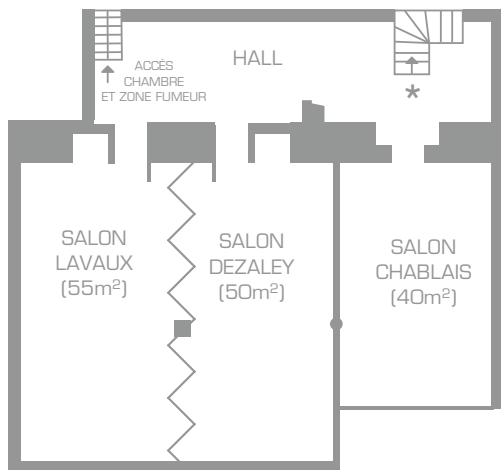

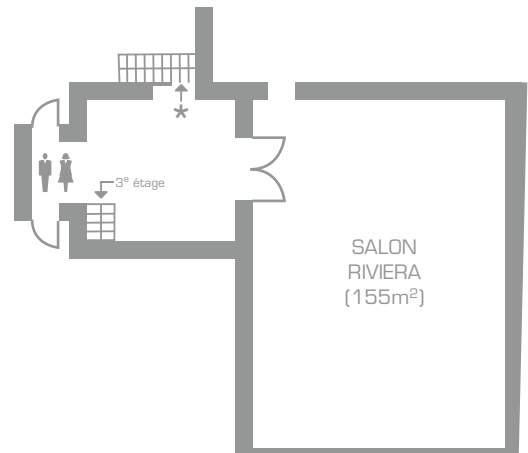

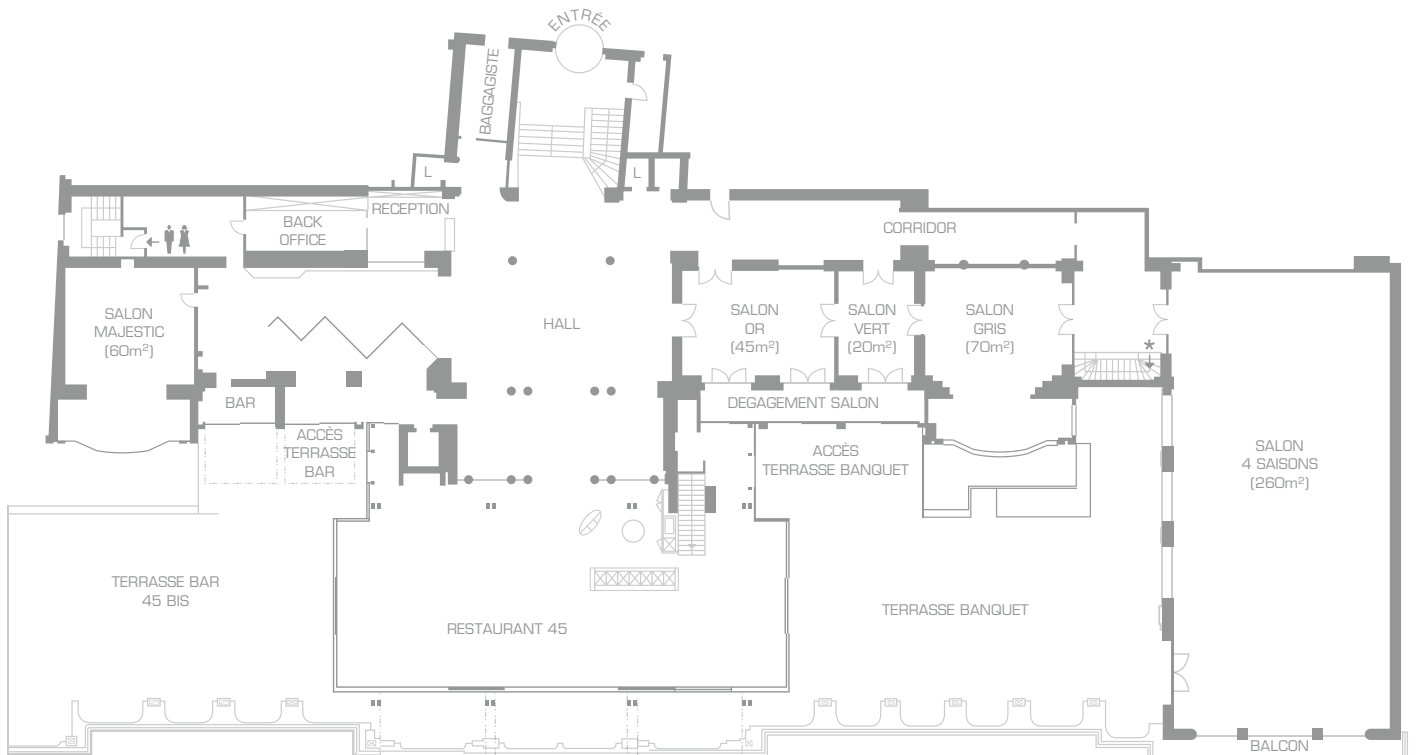

### **Insurance, liability**

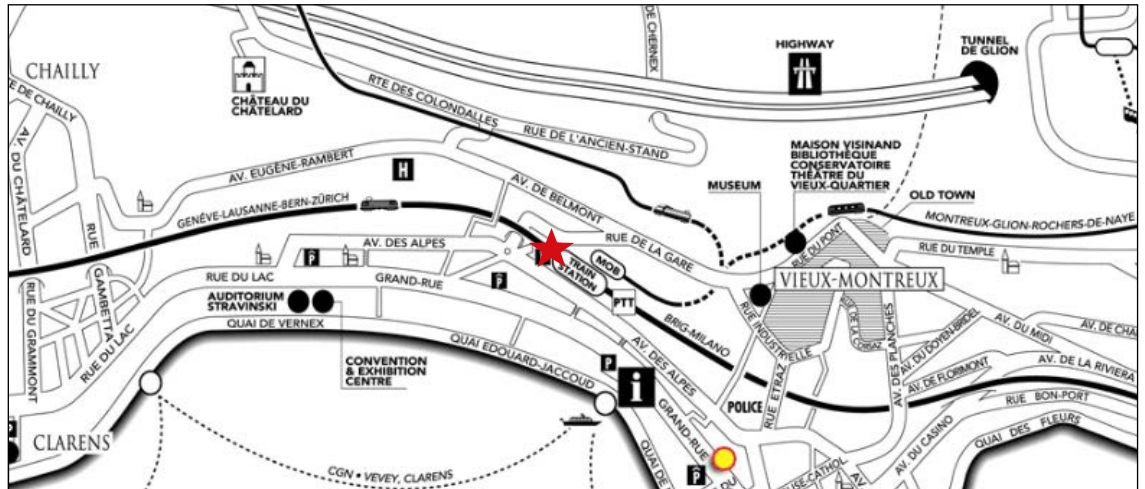
